1. **We don't have an office.** The Armory lets us use their space the week before Christmas but they can't help you because they don't work with us on the project.
2. One application per household
  - Print Clearly
  - Sign your application
3. Only apply for children for whom you have legal custody. BE PREPARED TO SHOW PROOF OF CUSTODY.
4. **MAIL** your application in an envelope to **Christmas Committee, PO Box 755, Anoka MN 55303**
  - Due date **November 27<sup>th</sup>, Postmarked on or before November 27<sup>th</sup>**
  - Use a 49 cent stamp
5. We will send you a postcard mid-Dec. if we approve your request. It will give your appointment date and time
  - You will have to come to the Armory on 4<sup>th</sup> and Main Street in Anoka to choose your toys and pick up your food.
  - **Your appointment will be between 8:00AM & 3:30PM on December 18<sup>th</sup> or 19<sup>th</sup>**
  - You can send someone to choose your toys and pick up food if you can't.
    - Give them a note that tells your name and tells us that you give them your permission to pick up for you. They have to bring your appointment card and ID plus their own ID.
6. If you don't have a car, ask someone you know for a ride. Or, use the bus, taxi, or the Traveler. Call the Traveler at least one day ahead at 763-323-5222.
7. Clients without children are still eligible to apply just leave the section for children blank.
8. IF YOU ARE DISABLED and homebound, check the box on the application. Local Law Enforcement and Fire Fighters will make home deliveries sometime either on December 18<sup>th</sup> or 19<sup>th</sup>
